HOWEVER, IT APPEARS 14 SHE NEEDS TO INCREASE HER COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS IN ORDER TO 15 COMPLETE COMMUMITY SERVICE, WITHIN THE ONE YEAR PERIOD STIPULATED 16 BY THE COURT. THE DEFENDANT SHOULD BE ADMONISHED TO BE MORE 17 DELIGENT IN HER EFFORTS.
